2. CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES OF COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON 16 FEBRUARY 2022

3. ELECTRONIC MOTIONS TO BE RATIFIED	
The committee ratified the following motion, which was emailed by Andrea to all committee members on 15 March 2022, and was electronically approved: that an amount of \$4,973.00 (including GST) be expended from the Rabaul and Montevideo Maru Reserve to erect a commemorative seat (\$3,686.00) and sign board (\$1,287.00) for the sinking of the MS Montevideo Maru at Mornington Memorial Park on the Mornington Peninsula in Victoria.	
The committee ratified the following motion, which was emailed by Murrough to all committee members on 18 April 2022, and was electronically approved: that the PNGAA Financial Statements for the year ended 31 December 2021 be adopted.	
4. WRAP UP OF 2022 AGM

5. NOTIFICATION TO NSW FAIR TRADING OF CHANGE OF PUBLIC OFFICER AND OFFICIAL ADDRESS Gaynor confirmed she had ordered and received from Fair Trading an extract in relation to documents available on the Public Register. It showed Murrough Benson as public officer and 37 Findlay Avenue, Roseville NSW 2069 as the official address. Gaynor is preparing a Form A9 Notice of appointment of public officer and Notice of change of association address for signature by Chris Pearsall and lodgement with Fair Trading, to be followed by lodgement of Form A12 - T2 Annual summary of financial affairs Tier 2 before 27 May.
